## Carl Laurie presents to at-risk youths at The Work Group.

### Wagner Resources Inc. employee recounts life in Iraq as a Freedom of Information Act Specialist

Pennsauken, NJ- April 15, 2009- Carl Laurie, an employee at Wagner-Resources, Inc. (WRI) was asked to speak to a group of at-risk youth at The Work Group located in Pennsauken, New Jersey. The Work Group equips at-risk youth in transition to adulthood with the skills, education, and confidence to become self-directed, self-sufficient individuals who are productive and responsible members of their families and communities. The program operates the NJ Youth Corps program, a voluntary program for young people who have dropped out of school.

Mr. Laurie discussed what it is like living in Iraq, showing the class pictures of everyday life for him at Camp Victory. He also talked about the work he does as a Freedom of Information Act Specialist, his career in the United States Air Force, and answered questions the youth presented to him. Mr. Laurie encouraged the students to make good choices for themselves, to not fall into the trap of the streets, and to stay focused on the goals they have set for themselves.
